



## About Net of Compassion:

**Net of Compassion** is a non profit organization serving the homeless and indigent. What started as one man's simple commitment to "love thy neighbor" has grown into a network of more than 100 volunteers, offering weekly meals, peer counseling, recovery supports, and Hotel Grace, a 50-bed, emergency cold-weather shelter.

It is estimated that there are more than 1,100 homeless individuals in Worcester. While much attention to the plight of children and homeless families has made a positive difference for that population, individuals considered street homeless have increased 97% and chronically homeless 46%. Many have untreated mental illness, suffer from addiction, are victims of abuse or sex trafficking, or have other issues that make it nearly impossible for them to access traditional services.

From Saturdays on Main Street, to street outreach and Hotel Grace, nearly 3,000 of our most vulnerable neighbors are touched by Net of Compassion each year.

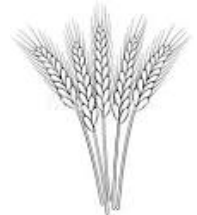
